Local Fiber Joins the Market

Welcome - **Woolly Gals Locally Farmed Fiber!** Joining us for the remainder of the season, this local cooperative represents two farms producing fiber... together creating a knitter's paradise on Boistfort Street each Tuesday.

Mountain Niche Farm (Adna) offers yarns from a variety of wools: Shetland Sheep, Romney Sheep, Navajo-Churro Sheep and, some blends with Alpaca wool. Autumn Hills Woollens (Curtis) offers yarn made of a blend of Merino and Blue-Faced Leicester wools.

The majority of yarns offered are machine spun and then dyed by the farmers when it comes back from the mill. Some hand spun yarns are also available, as well as fibers ready to spin and roving from Merino, Shetland, Navajo-Churro or crosses.
